Job Summary

This is an hourly position, and the hours are primarily from 7:30 am to 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday. Weekly schedules may change based on work-related or seasonal needs, which may include nights or weekends as requested.

Job Qualifications

A high school degree/GED is required. A basic knowledge in facility mechanics, aquatic mechanics, and grounds maintenance. Must have the following certifications/licenses: CPR Certification within six months after hire. You must possess a valid Illinois Class D Driver's License at time of hire. Tradespecific Certification is a plus.

All employees must pass a criminal background check and drug test, which are paid for by the Park District of Forest Park.

Required Knowledge

A basic knowledge of facility mechanics, aquatic mechanics and grounds maintenance is required.

Required Skills

Needs to be willing to learn all aspects of pools, including: chemical balancing, backwashing, filter cleaning, general cleaning, filling/winterizing. This position includes an opportunity to became a Certified Pool Operator.

Need to be willing to learn the basic knowledge regarding facility mechanics.
